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DEVELOPMENT OF CREATIVE SKILLS OF STUDENTS OF ARTISTIC SPECIALITIES IN THE PROCESS OF PERFORMING SKETCHES AND DRAFTS FROM NATURE

The objective of the research is to reveal the theoretical aspect of the concept of "creative abilities"; to analyze the development of creative abilities of students of artistic specialities in the process of performing sketches and drafts from nature; to describe the main goals and sequence of performing sketches and drafts.

Creativity is the internal need of a person to reflect their own vision of a particular problem, an issue that requires certain experience, certain knowledge and skills. The result of assimilation of information is the opportunity to create, to reflect another facet of reality. Creativity is manifested in all spheres of society's activity, in particular, and of a specific person: organizational, scientific, artistic, etc.

Presentation of the problem in general form. Creativity is the highest level of mental activity of a person, as a result of which the person, the forms and ways of thinking, personal qualities change. The development of creative abilities of students of artistic specialities is extremely urgent problem, the solution of which will have a positive effect on the formation of professional skills of future teachers.

Analysis of researches and publications. Numerous psychological and pedagogical researches are dedicated to the classification of the creative process, which ensures the further formation of a creative personality (I. Bekh, L. Vyhotskyi, V. Druzhynin, P. Enhelmeier, A. Maslow, Ya. Ponomariov, T. Ribo, V. Romanets, H. Selie, R. Stenberg, S. Symonenko, L. Turishcheva, G. Wallace, Z. Freud, Yu. Chernozhuk, V. Shynkarenko, S. Ship and other). Thus, for example, G. Wallace distinguishes four phases of the psychological process: the phase of idea preparation; the phase of idea maturation; the phase of splash of the idea; the phase of testing of the idea.

Creative abilities are a set of such traits of a person's character that meet the requirements of a certain type of creative activity and cause an objectively high result of this activity. "In order to achieve them, an "engine" is needed that would start the thinking mechanism, that is, desires and will are necessary, a "motivational basis" is needed". [1, p. 15].

Presentation of the main research material. Student's artistic activity is impossible without stimulating the development of their creative abilities.

Creativity is the internal need of a person, a peculiar form of reflection of reality, which contributes to the creation of new ways of activity in revealing images and concepts. It requires certain experience, certain knowledge and skills. The result of assimilation of information is the opportunity to create, the opportunity to reveal the creative abilities, forming another facet of reality.

The development of creative abilities of students of artistic specialities in the process of making sketches and drafts from nature involves long-term training in drawing and painting. Sketching gives an opportunity to reflect the first impression of nature in all its uniqueness.

Work on sketches and drafts requires compliance with the basic principle of performing practical works in visual arts – from the general to the specific. For this, an important condition is compliance with the sequence of representation of objects from nature.

Depicting people and animals requires students to be more persistent and have certain skills and knowledge of anatomy. This creative process is accompanied by performing a series of purposeful sketches.

Performing sketches and drafts of a moving model requires, in addition to general visual skills, the skills of observation, visual memory, and the ability to quickly grasp the main thing. Drawing inanimate objects, the artist can refine the proportions for a long time, measure the sketch, gradually bringing it to perfection. But the images of people, animals and birds must be done quickly.

Sketches and drafts play an important role in the process of creating a thematic composition. While working on it, the artist makes a large number of sketches, drafts,

rough drawings from nature, from imagination, from memory in order to find the best images to reveal the main idea of the future work.

Conclusions and prospects for further researches. Thus, the performing of sketches and drafts has a positive effect on the development of creative abilities of students of artistic specialities, which, in turn, contributes to the improvement of the professional skills of future art teachers. The development of creative abilities in the process of making sketches and drafts is achieved by high efficiency, perseverance and regular classes.
